Attending veterinarian and adequate veterinary care (dealers and exhibitors).

The following veterinary concerns were noted during the inspection:

A female Djungarian hamster was seen with significant swelling of the upper and lower left eyelids, such that the eye could not be opened. There is a mild amount of clear discharge present and redness throughout the eyelids, though the rest of the animal appeared normal. While husbandry has been performed routinely, facility records most recently document that these animals were scanned for sickness on November 11, 2024.

Two "Skinny guinea pigs" (one is black and white, and the other one is black and tan) that arrived at the facility on November 12, 2024, housed in lane 4, cage rack L of the guinea pig area, are both found to be in thin body condition with their backbones easily observed. Also, the black and white guinea pig has multiple rounded, crusting skin lesions over the back and neck. Per a facility representative, these animals had already received their daily observations this morning and these issues have not been noted at this morning's daily observation or since their acquisition two days ago.

In another enclosure in Lane 4, a black "Skinny guinea pig" is observed with multiple healing scratches across its back starting behind its shoulders, continuing down its back to across its rump, with associated scabbing that was not previously noted on daily observation logs including this morning's daily observation that had already occurred.

These conditions were not identified by the facility and thus the attending veterinarian had not yet been contacted, nor had appropriate veterinary care been administered. Failure to adequately observe animals for unmanaged health concerns may delay care and cause undue pain, discomfort, or stress. The facility must maintain a more comprehensive method to perform daily observations of all animals to identify problems and to assure direct and timely communication with the attending veterinarian.

Upon recognition of these animals' conditions by the inspectors, the animals were transferred to another area for care and monitoring and examination by the veterinarian.

Primary enclosures.

In the bird building containing the recently weaned parakeets, Inspectors noticed one blue and black parakeet outside of its enclosure. The parakeet was seen on the bottom of the metal rack sleeping. Birds that escape their primary enclosures could injure themselves, spread diseases, or get lost in the building. Primary enclosures must be constructed and maintained so that they contain the birds securely.
